The President will call for public comment on each agenda item at the appropriate time and all votes will be taken by roll call.

Due to State guidelines on physical distancing in public gatherings, the Boardroom can accommodate a maximum occupancy of 14 members of the public at one time. Members of the public shall be admitted on a first-come basis with no reservations. When the occupancy maximum of 14 is reached, any remaining individuals will be directed to attend via video/teleconference remotely.
